Re: 8 Hour Ozone SIP for the Denver Metropolitan and North Front  
Range Area Ozone Action Plan

Commission Members:

In the matter of proposed revisions to Ambient Air Quality Standards Regulation, Regulation numbers 3, 7, and 11, the NFRMPO is the Lead Planning Agency designated by the Governor of the State of Colorado in the North Front Range area. The NFRMPO has been involved in the development of the SIP and the proposed control measures.

The NFRMPO Planning Council, composed of 15 local elected officials from our member governments, has concurred with and approved the recommended emissions control strategies as presented in the 8 Hour Ozone Action Plan with one exception.

This exception concerns the current Action Plan recommendation of a 95% control using a threshold method on condensate tanks. The NFRMPO supports the concept of a **systemwide control of 90%**.

We appreciate your consideration of our recommendation.
